

I don't know how to say justice in American. In the family court system, I was silenced and sentenced--an innocent criminal charged with possession of childhood.

This government conveniently praises the resilience of childhood when it is presenting flowers to dignitaries, but blinds itself to the resilient children whose spirits break as The Blind Justice is further choked by a robe-clad man incapable of empathy. "He has obstructed the Administration of Justice." (Declaration of Independence). The government regards anyone under the age of 18 as property, tossed across a courtroom on a whim and an unseen handshake. I flew to California with two foreign humans as my jailers. I received "treatment" from a disgraced and disbarred former mental health professional. I lived with an abusive man for over a year. Justice is not for all Americans.

Every cruel soul skulking the family court system perceives him or herself as god, capable of discerning beyond facts and worthy of levying unjust judgment. People who never saw the tears crawl across my face exacted despicable judgement, but someone saw it all.
